## The first steps toward the revolution

The Estates-General (=Versammlung von Mitgliedern aller 3 Stände der Gesellschaft) met for over a month and did not agree on the voting system. In **June 1789** the representatives (dt. Abgeordnete) of the Third Estate decided not to accept the power of the First and Second Estate. The called themselves National Assembly (dt. Nationalversammlung). They said that they were the only ones who really represented the French people.

The king was angry and closed the meeting room of the Third Estate. Three days later they met at the **Tennis Court House** (dt. *Ballhaus*) and took an oath: **the Tennis Court Oath** (dt. Ballhausschwur). They swore that they would stay together until France was ruled by the French people and not by a king who did not help them.
